Lime Kiln marked on both 1st and 2nd edition OS historic mapping.		

PRN130852	Boundary	SR 97050 93964
An abandoned boundary is recorded and identified by the National Trust. The boundary follows the trackway up to the pool and is recorded on the 1868 Cawdor Archive map.		



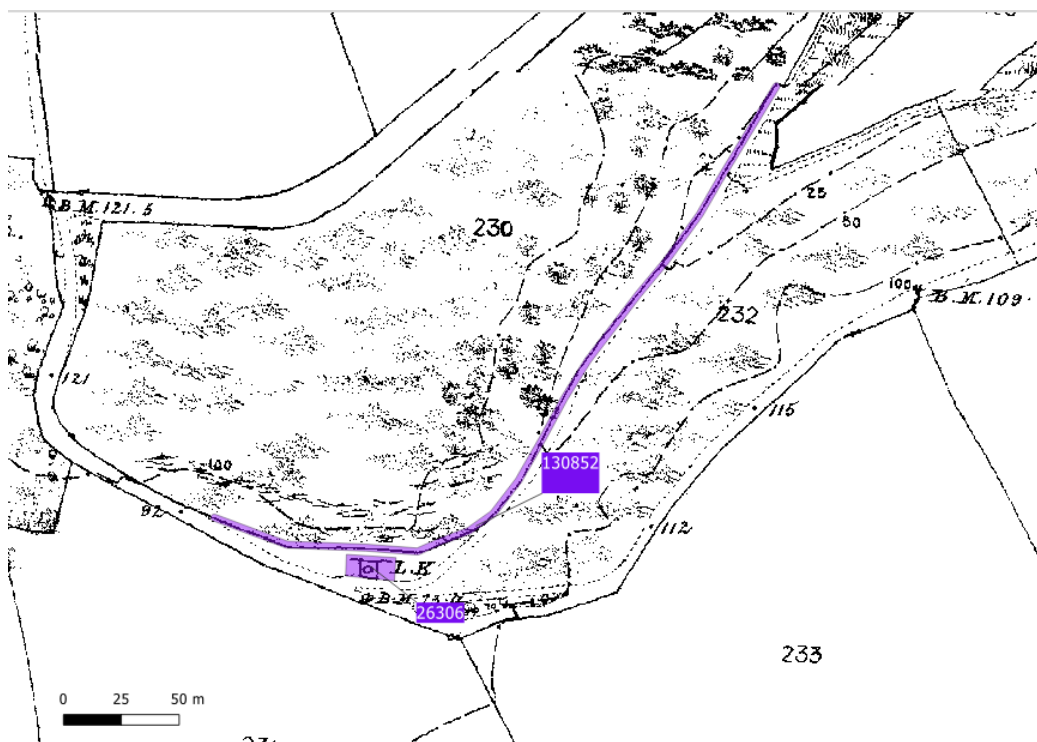

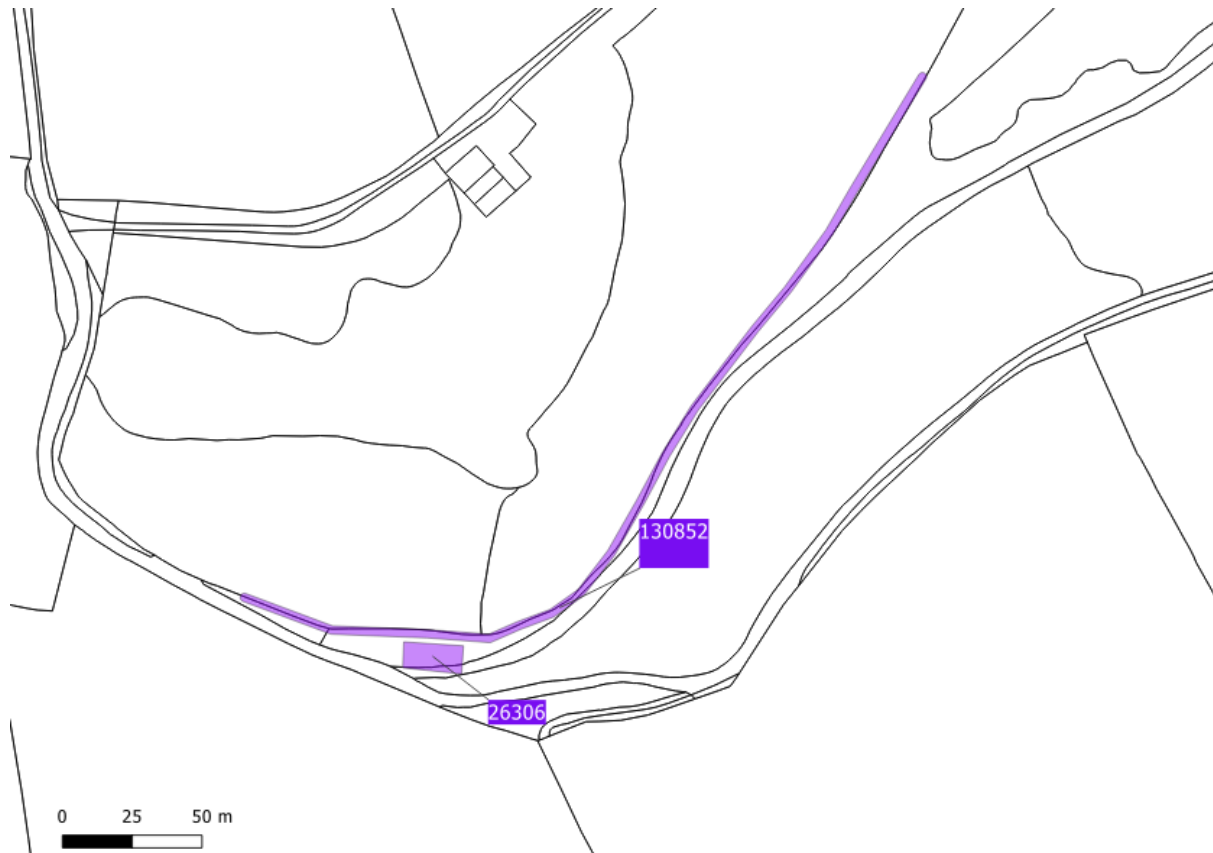

The current condition of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as a ruin, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that the historic environment features (labelled on the maps above and marked with a green polygon) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Heneb – The Trust for Welsh Archaeology, Heritage Management Dyfed region is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
