

Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that this application lies within the Historical Landscape Character Area of Rhos Penboy <https://dyfedarchaeology.org.uk/HLC/drefachfelindre/rhospenboyr.htm> which describes this area as treeless apart from modern coniferous plantations. Historic maps show that prior to afforestation it was open common land used for grazing animals.

In addition, I have also noted the following feature recorded on the Historic Environment Record:
