Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note that consultation areas 1a and 1b lie within the Historic Landscape Character Area Cilgwyn - Llwynwormwood. Compartments 2a and 2b lie within the Historic Landscape Character Area Ystrad Tywi: Llangadog-Llandovery.

We advise that these historic environment features (labelled on the map above and marked with a green polygon or red dot) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.
