## **FLA 154 24-25 CWM GLOYNE**

Thank you for consulting us on the felling licence application for Cwm Gloyne near Felindre. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources, and I note the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area:

### **PRN 50025 – Quarry** (SN10543955)

Identified as "old quarry" on the Ordnance Survey 1st edition map (1889), suggesting that it was abandoned by that time. This site has not been visited recently, so its current condition is unknown.

The historic features within the woodland should be protected from damage during forestry operations, including tree felling and removal or when tracking machinery across them.

Additionally, the woodland lies adjacent to the scheduled monument of Cwm Gloyn Camp (PE306, PRN 963, 964), an Iron Age Promontory Fort. All forestry operations must ensure that this scheduled area (marked in red on the attached map) is unaffected. Should there be any potential impact on the scheduled area, please contact Cadw for further advice.

There are also a number of possible Prehistoric standing stones in the area (PRNs 94281, 94285 & 94286), and it is essential that these features are not affected in any way during the woodland felling. The presence of the Promontory Fort and standing stones indicates a high level of Prehistoric activity in the area, so we advise extra caution.


