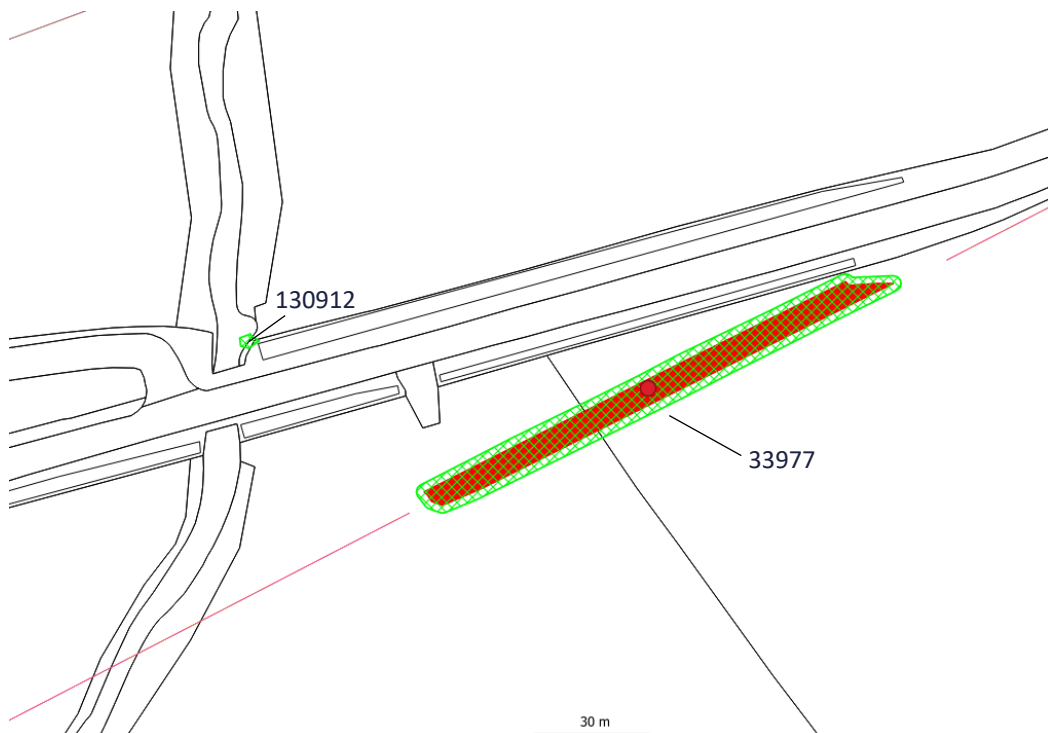

**NRW Screening Request DFR/S/2025/0007
Flood Risk Activity Permit Application**

Thank you for the Flood Risk Activity Permit Application consultation for operations South of Glanmynys, Llandovery. I have reviewed the provided map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and noted the following features.

PRN33977 GLAN-MYNYS ROMAN ROAD SN73353245
A short segment of Roman road RR623 between Llandeilo and Llandovery identified as a parchmark in farmland from aerial photographs where modern road line diverges from route of Roman road. Ploughing in 1971 produced metalling of the original causeway. DS.09.2004.

PRN130912 GLAN-MYNYS STONE SN7324732462
Stone recorded on 1st Edition Ordnance Survey Map. We have no knowledge of the condition of this feature. A. Powell 2025.
