**NRW Screening Request DFR/S/2024/0136 Freshwater West Beach
Flood Risk Activity Permit Application**

Thank you for the Flood Risk Activity Permit Application consultation for the removal of a blockage within the pipe/culvert, Freshwater West Beach, Freshwater West. I have reviewed the provided map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and noted the following features.

PRN4675 GUPTON BURROWS BRIDGE POST MEDIEVAL BRIDGE SR88559974
A single-arched stone bridge. 30m downstream, a stone-built arched culvert directs the stream beneath the sandy storm beach/dunes. Km 1996.
Built C18th. It is Grade II Listed.

PRN130899 PENDINE POST MEDIEVAL SLUICE SR8852299692
Sluice recorded on 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Map. A. Powell 2024.

PRN130900 PENDINE POST MEDIEVAL BUILDING SR8855499684
Building recorded on 2nd Edition Ordnance Survey Map. A. Powell 2025.





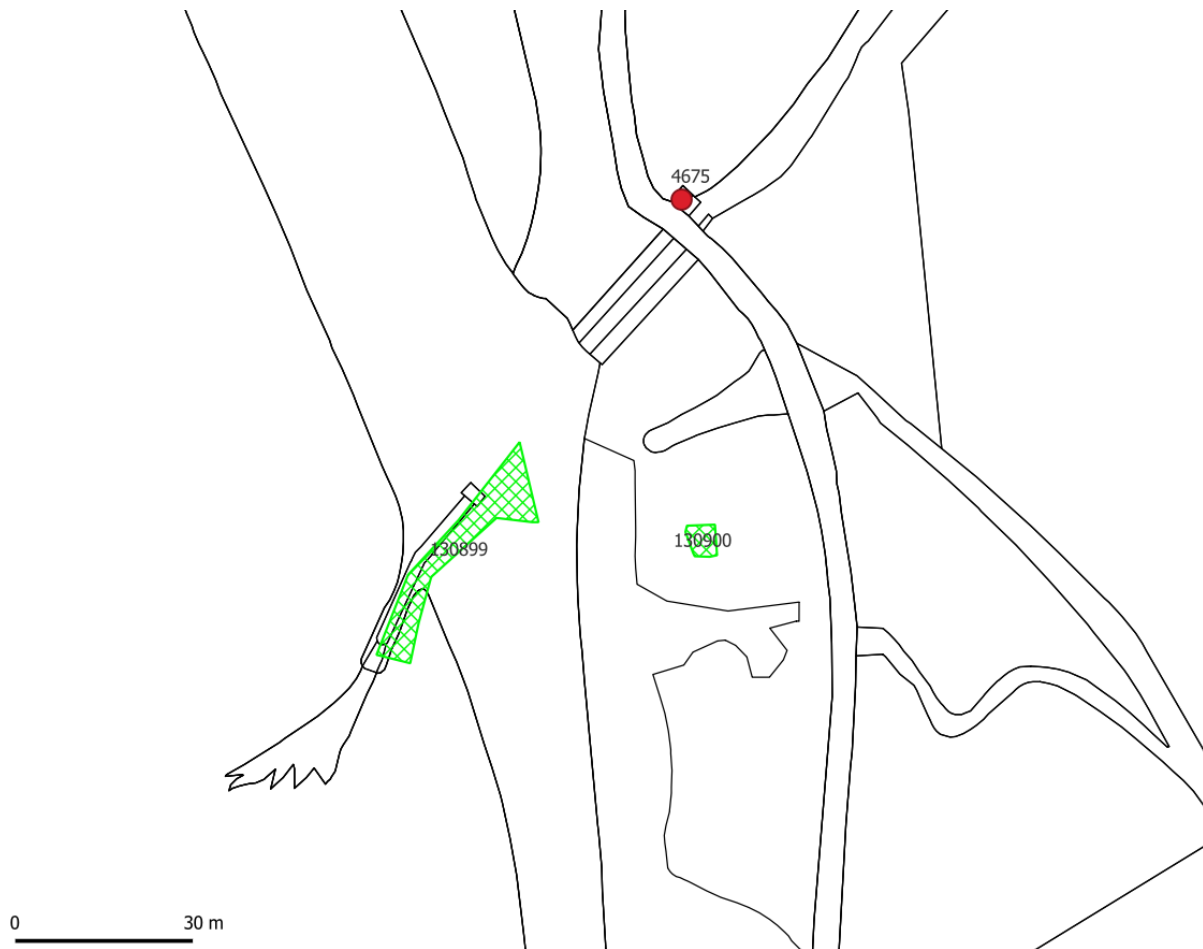
