NRW Screening Request FLA157 23-24 Stradey Estate.

Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following features:

PRN98709POST MEDIEVAL COTTAGESN49350420A rectangular enclosure is depicted within woodland on the Ordnance Survey 1stedition map (1880 Carms. Sheet 54.10, 25). Possibly a former cottage or farmstead site.

The current condition of this feature is unknown; however, it may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that this historic environment feature (labelled on the map above and marked with a red start and green polygon) is protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
