We do not consider the proposals for land-spreading of waste to have a detrimental impact on this feature, which exhibits no above-ground remains. However archaeological deposits may survive in this area, so ground intrusive activities should be avoided.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
