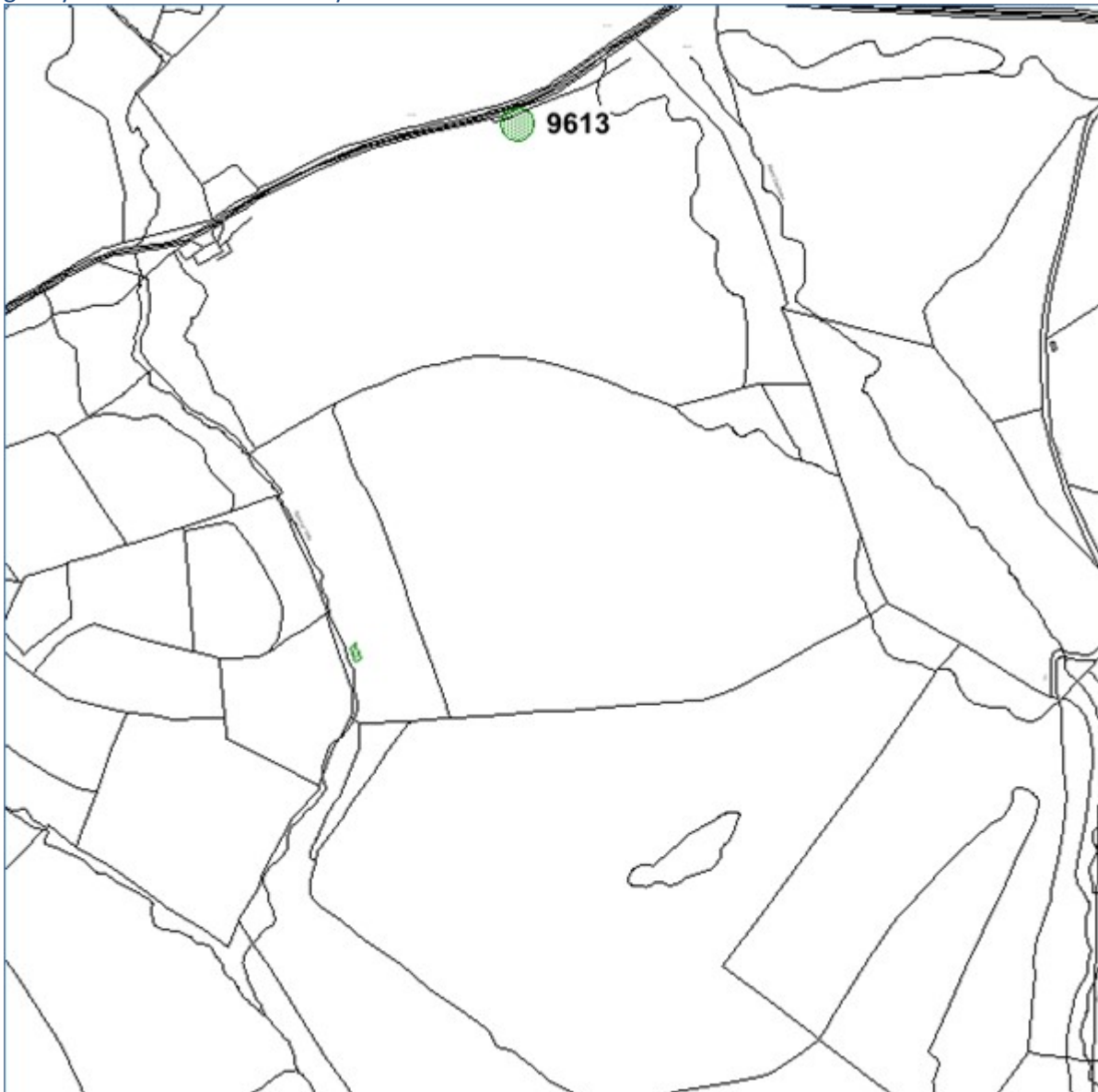

Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic environment features recorded within the consultation area;

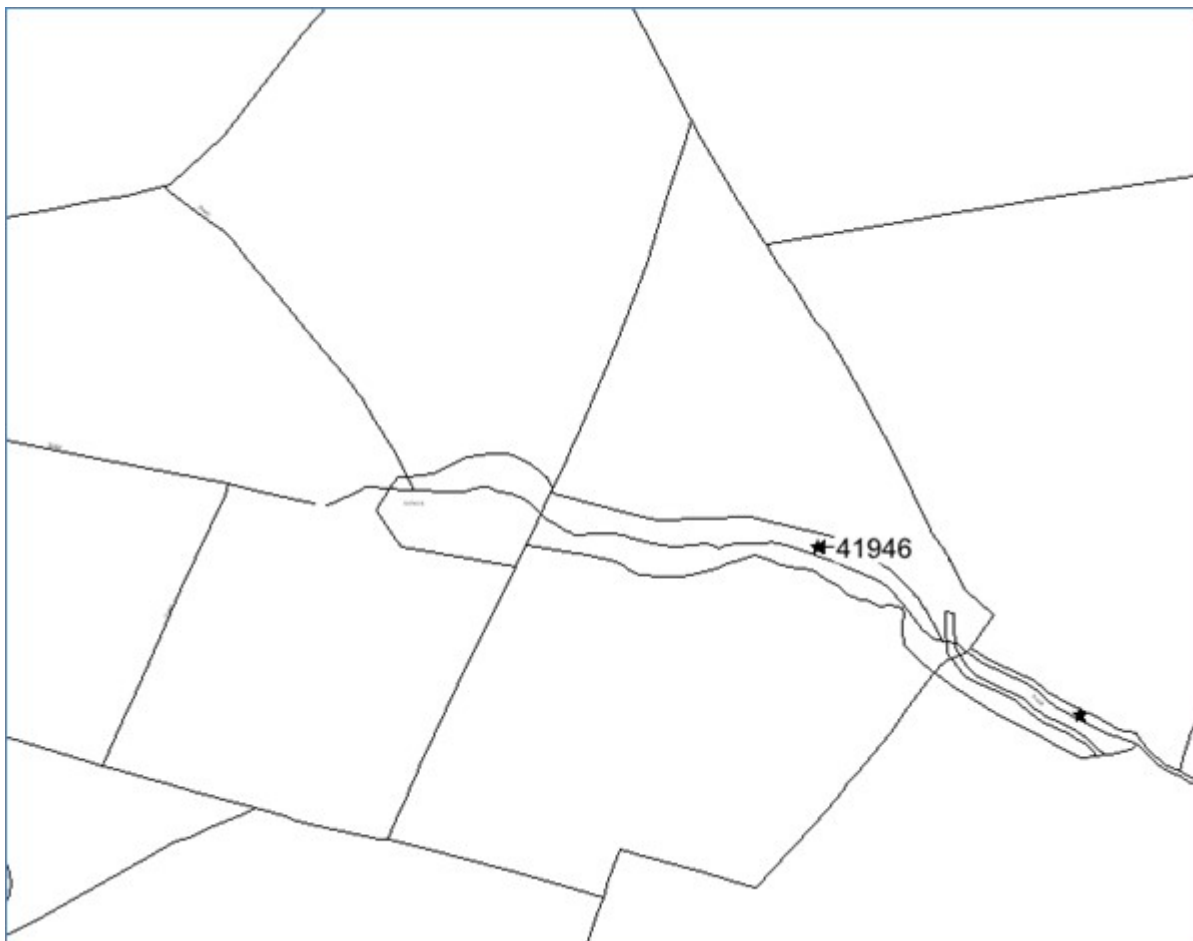
PRN9613 Bronze Age Round Barrow SN581421

Lots of large angular blocks of stone make up the cairn material of this barrow, and these are all visible on its surface. In the centre of the mound there are some large white quartz blocks, and it looks as though the cairn has been robbed, perhaps for material when the boundary walls nearby were constructed. The cairn is clearly circular, 10m in diameter, and stands to a height of c. 0.35m. It is located in a pasture field in undulating land sloping down gently to the S and E. N Bestley PFRS 2001



PRN 41946 POST MEDIEVAL DWELLING SN48434310

Site of former cottage, first recorded on the tithe survey of 1840 as two detached buildings, orientated north south with small enclosures to the northwest and southeast. The owners cannot remember seeing any remains in this area and its position is probably only marked by a slight levelling in the field, just to the north of a stream. However, a story was told in the family that the field was haunted by a white ghost which may have related to the occupants of the cottage that once stood here. It was approached by a trackway from the south (PRN 41972).

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
