Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic environment feature recorded within the consultation area:

### CRUG LAS

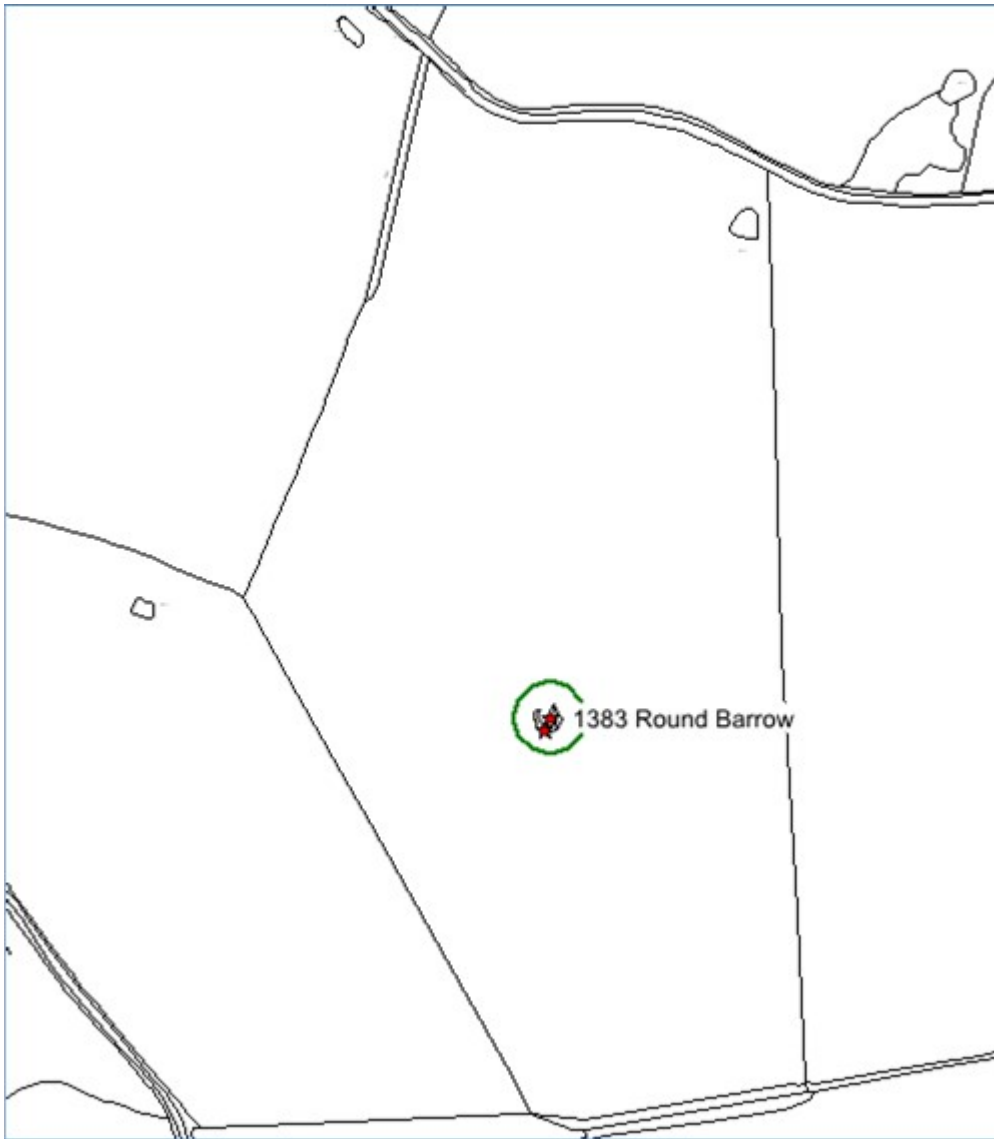

### Summary :

All that remains of the round barrow is a barely perceptible mound c.15m in diameter and 0.25m high, on top of which there are seven concrete cube-shaped blocks forming an L shape. The landowner buried his father in the barrow in 1979 and also his wife in 2003. There is one large stone with an anvil-shaped stone placed on top of it commemorating the death of the landowner's father. Several other large stones have been cleared to the site in addition to the concrete blocks on top of the mound. N Cook 2006
