Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following historic environment records within the consultation area;

**Primary Reference Number (PRN) : 11848**

**NGR : SN643655**

**Site Type (preferred type first) : Post Medieval Carved Stone / Medieval Carved Stone / POST MEDIEVAL Carved Stone**

**Summary :**

*Found at Cae'r Fynwent, Godregarth, and exhibited by Mr S M Powell at Tregaron in 1931. It is an undressed fragment of local stone on one face of which is a 'trident'. This decoration has been pecked out, not carved. It's date is uncertain. Possibly a mason's mark.*

*Its current location is not recorded. A similar stone is built into the wall of Tregaron churchyard (PRN 11850)*

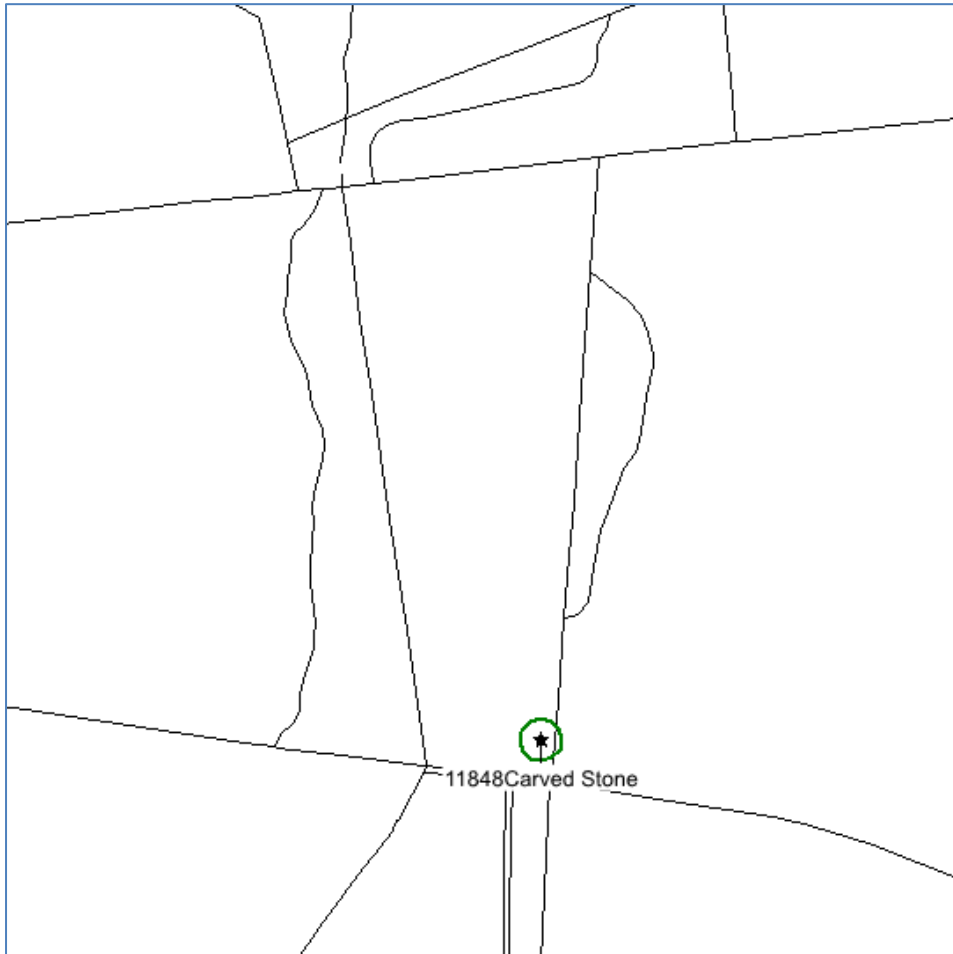
