FLA 90 19-20 Allt Pistyll Dew

Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and there are no specific Historic Environment Assets recorded within the consultation area.

The consultation area lies within the Registered Landscape of Outstanding Historic Interest, Tywi Valley (HLW (D) 5) and the Historic Landscape Character Area of Allt Pant Mawr:

It lies just beyond, though contiguous with the area defined as the 'Essential Setting' for Paxton's Tower which is a Grade II* Registered Historic Park and Garden (PGW (Dy) 49 (CAM). The historic map evidence shows that this area was deciduous woodland in the 19th century. Therefore the historic landscape character would be restored by restocking in mixed broadleaf woodland species.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
