

PRN 121904 PERIOD POST MEDIEVAL TYPE WELL NGR SN66845237 SUMMARY A well is recorded on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map 1888. We have no information on the condition of these historic features; they may survive as ruinous structures, earthworks, or as only below ground remains. We therefore recommend that the areas identified on the map above as green polygons should be treated as archaeologically sensitive, and should be protected from potentially damaging forestry operations. Dyfed Archaeological Trust therefore advise that in order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, the following advice should be adhered to in the Glastir Woodland Creation plan: planting within the areas outlined on the accompanying map should be avoided. | | | |
