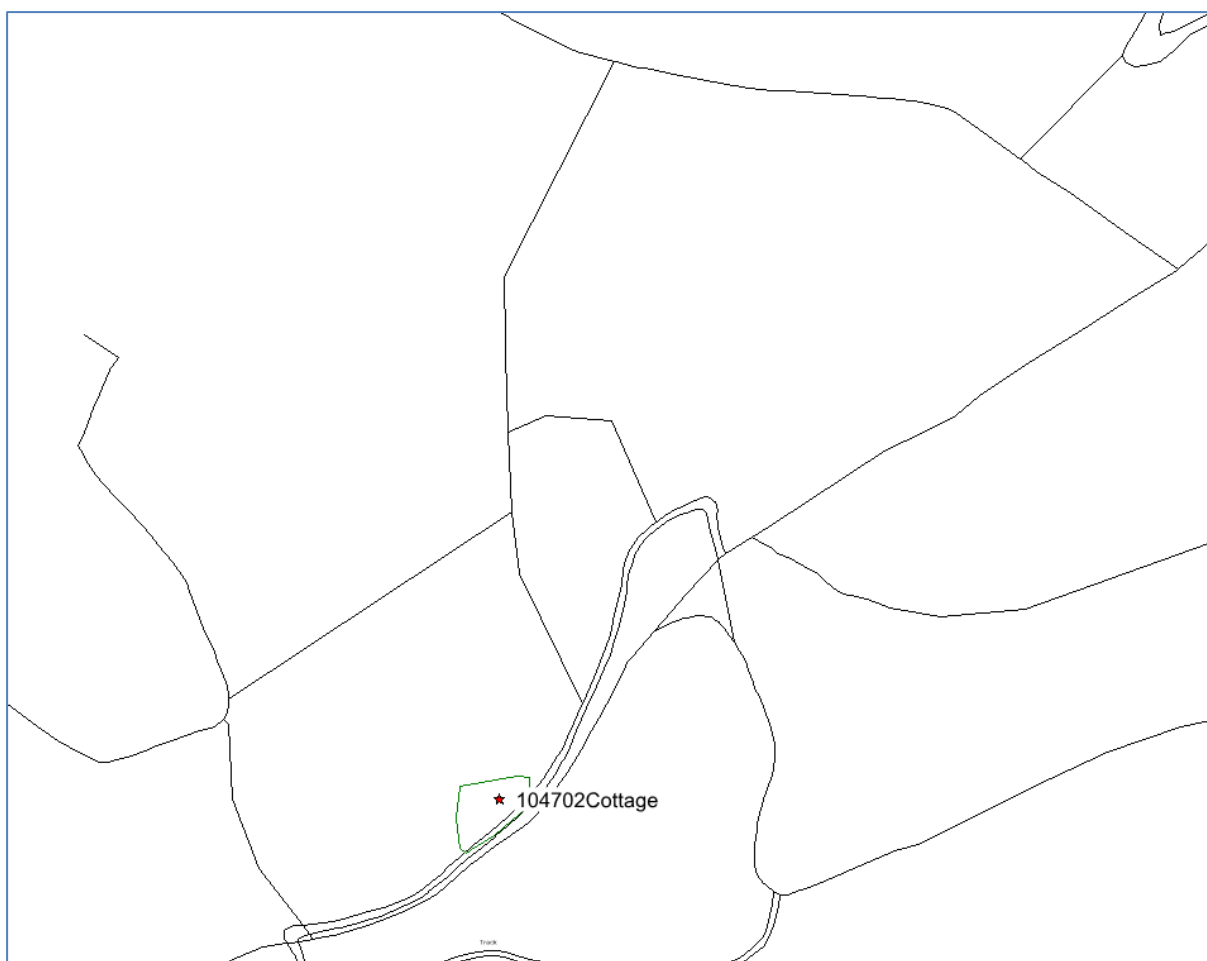

Decision (If the proposal is considered to be inappropriate at this location please provide an explanation)	<p>Thank you for forwarding this Glastir Woodland Creation proposal to us.</p> <p>Dyfed Archaeological Trust have reviewed the new planting proposals for Tyllwyd against the Historic Environment Records database and other readily available record sources and have assessed that the application, has the potential to have an impact upon the following Historic Environment Features (HEF's):</p> <p>PRN 104702 Post Medieval Cottage SN66857985</p> <p>The former cottage of Bryn-yr-eithin, recorded on the Ordnance Survey 1st edition mapping (1888). Present condition unknown, presumed abandoned.</p> <p>This consultation also lies within the Upland Ceredigion Registered Landscape of Outstanding Historic Interest (HLW (D) 2), which has been further described by the Historic Landscape Character Area Allt y Gwreiddyn (HLCA 67).</p> <p>Dyfed Archaeological Trust therefore advise that in order to comply with UKFS <i>Forests and the historic environment</i> guidance, the following advice should be adhered to in the Glastir Woodland Creation plan:</p> <p>planting within the areas outlined on the accompanying map should be avoided</p>
