We therefore recommend that the areas identified on the map above as green polygons should be treated as archaeologically sensitive, and should be protected from potentially damaging forestry operations.</p> <p>Dyfed Archaeological Trust therefore advise that in order to comply with UKFS <i>Forests and the historic environment</i> guidance, the following advice should be adhered to in the Glastir Woodland Restoration plan:  Planting within the areas outlined on the accompanying map should be avoided.</p>
