EIA (Agriculture) Regulations - Consultation Request

FARM NAME T036 Ty'n y Castell

Thank you for your EIA screening request for two land parcels at Ty'n y Castell Farm in north Ceredigion.

I have checked your map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record and other sources. There are no records of any significant historic environment features within the affected area. The only feature which is marked on the Ordnance Survey 1st edition 25" map (1887) shows a footpath running across the field parcel at NGR SN72877752 to SN72937761.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
