



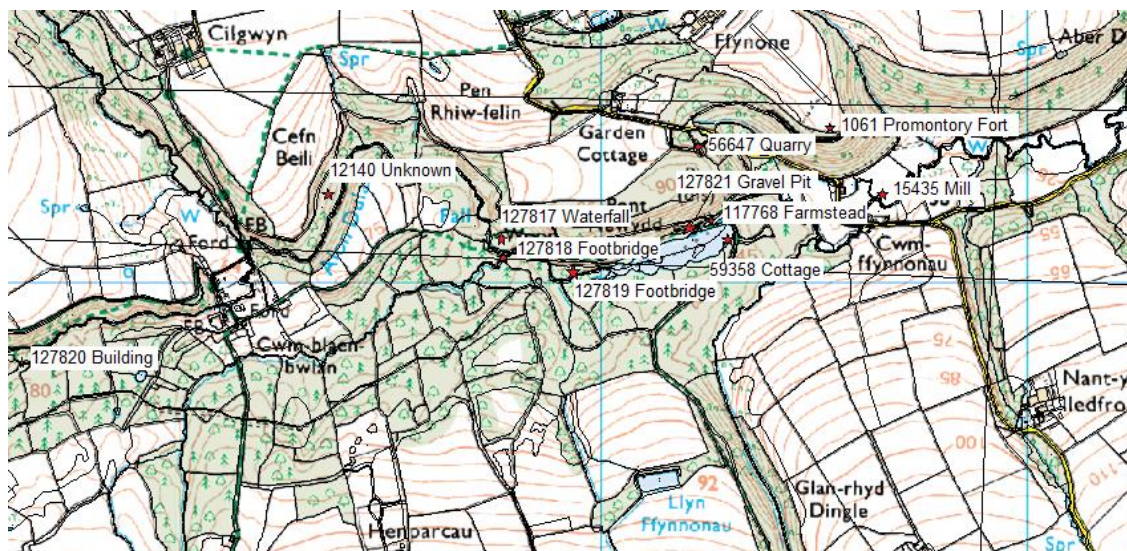

	<p>1966 confirmed a low bank cutting off the end of the promontory cutting off an area of c.3 acres. By 1977 the bank had been reduced to just 0.3m high.</p> <p>A site visit in 2007 failed to locate the bank - it is assumed to have been levelled. 15435	<p>The 1st edition of the historic 25-inch O. S. maps, published in 1889, depicts Felin Nant as a working corn mill, but the 2nd edition map (1907) depicts it as disused. Water came from a weir on the Afon Dulas to a small pond in the angle of the lane; its outline can still be seen. The stone-built two-storey mill house is still a dwelling, and a single storey building on the roadside may be the saw mill which is depicted on the 1907 map. 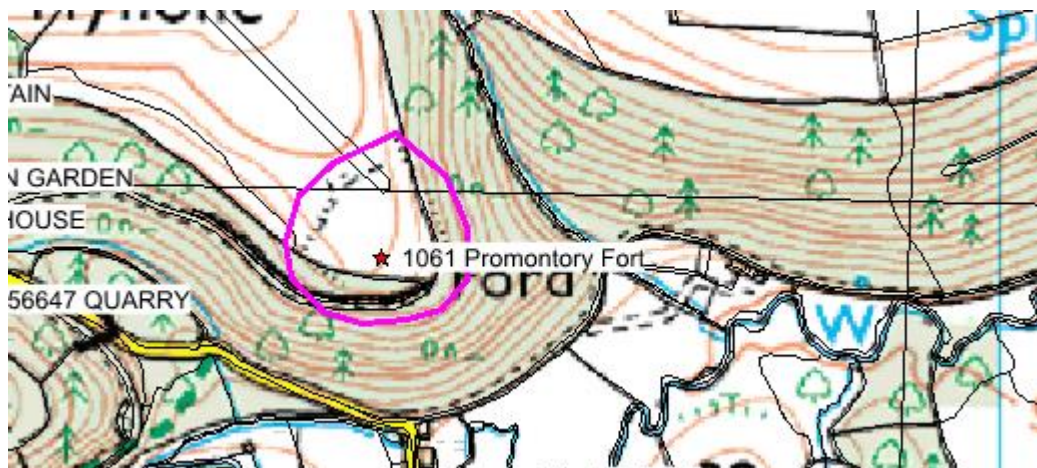

The current condition of some of these features is unknown; however they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Felling operations should avoid causing damage in these areas. The promontory fort, PRN 1061 highlighted in the map above, potentially has earthwork banks which are vulnerable to damage from machines working within this area. We recommend that machines are used with extreme caution in this area, especially when ground conditions are very wet. DAT HM can provide further advice if required.

The Felling Licence application also lies within Ffynnone Registered Parkland PGW (Dy) 18(PEM) (and essential setting) and Cilwendeg Essential Setting PGW (Dy) 17(PEM), in this instance we recommend that Cadw is also consulted regarding this application.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or
