

## NRW Screening Request FLA 331 23-24 Bryn Rhyd

Thank you for your consultation. I have checked the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and there are no known historic environment features recorded within the consultation area. Although, there are several archaeological features which lie just outside the consultation area which should be noted.

PRN13182 CERIG Y BELA MEDIEVAL LONGHUT SN67955267 Description suggests this to be a long hut type settlement site. RPS October 2001; Nothing was found at this location in 2002. There may have been some land improvement. RPS 2002.

PRN9585 CERIG Y BELA MEDIEVAL LONGHUT SN68105274 Stone foundations of a building. Description suggests this to be a long hut site. No further detail available. RPS October 2001; The area is reed covered with bad drainage. There was no sign of any DRS site at this grid reference. RPS December 2002.

The current condition of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as a ruin, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that these historic environment features (labelled on the map above and marked with a red star) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

The consultation area also falls with the Historic Landscape Character Area Cwm Berwyn.

We are do not know the extent of the "suggested long hut settlement site" and there are records for a cairn field in the surrounding area. There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge.
