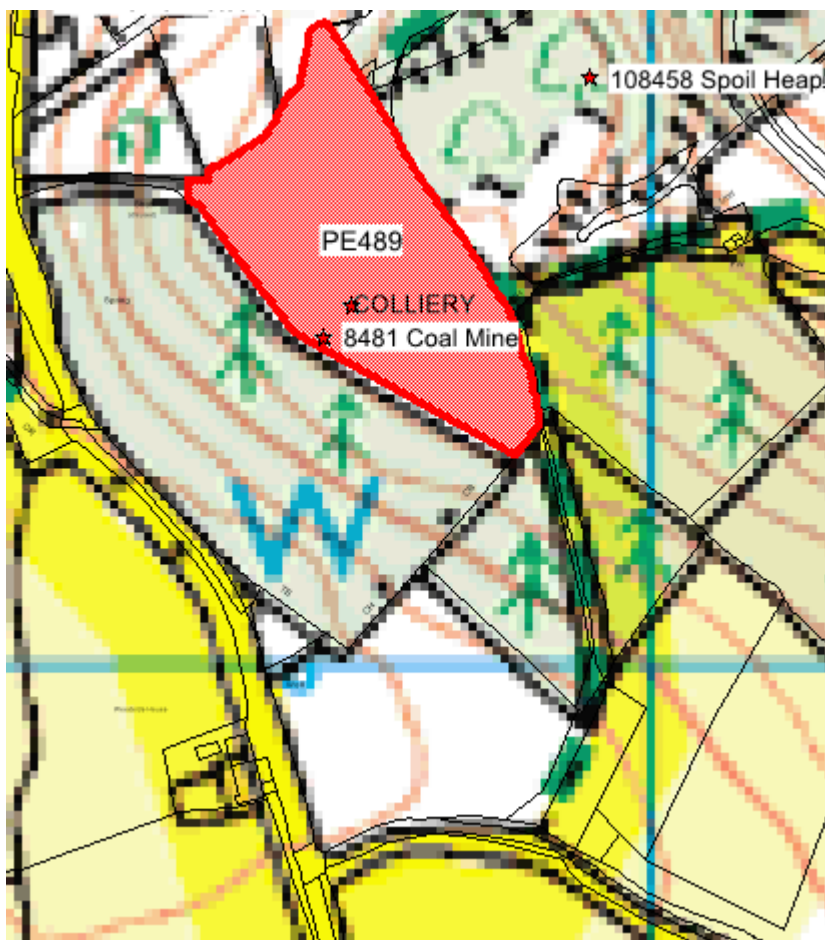



8481	Grove Colliery was established in 1853 by the Pembrokeshire Iron and Coal Company. The colliery had one shaft which was worked till 1884 and was then used for pumping and ventilation until c.1900. Many other buildings and sites are associated with the colliery. A.Day. March 2015.	Coal Mine	SN139071

One area of the application borders the above feature, which is also a Scheduled Monument (PE489), please seek advice from Cadw prior to any felling works. There is a strong probability of the presence of associated archaeological features and deposits nearby.

The current condition of some of these features is unknown; however they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Felling operations should avoid causing damage in these areas.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
