







The current condition of some of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. Therefore in order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, DAT advise that these historic environment features (shown outlined in red on the attached maps) must be protected from damage during felling operations and subsequent restocking, and tracks and loading areas must not cross these areas.

Although outside of the application area, it is recommended that Cadw be consulted due to the proximity of the application area to Scheduled Monument PRN 834 Defend Enclosure (CM149).
