



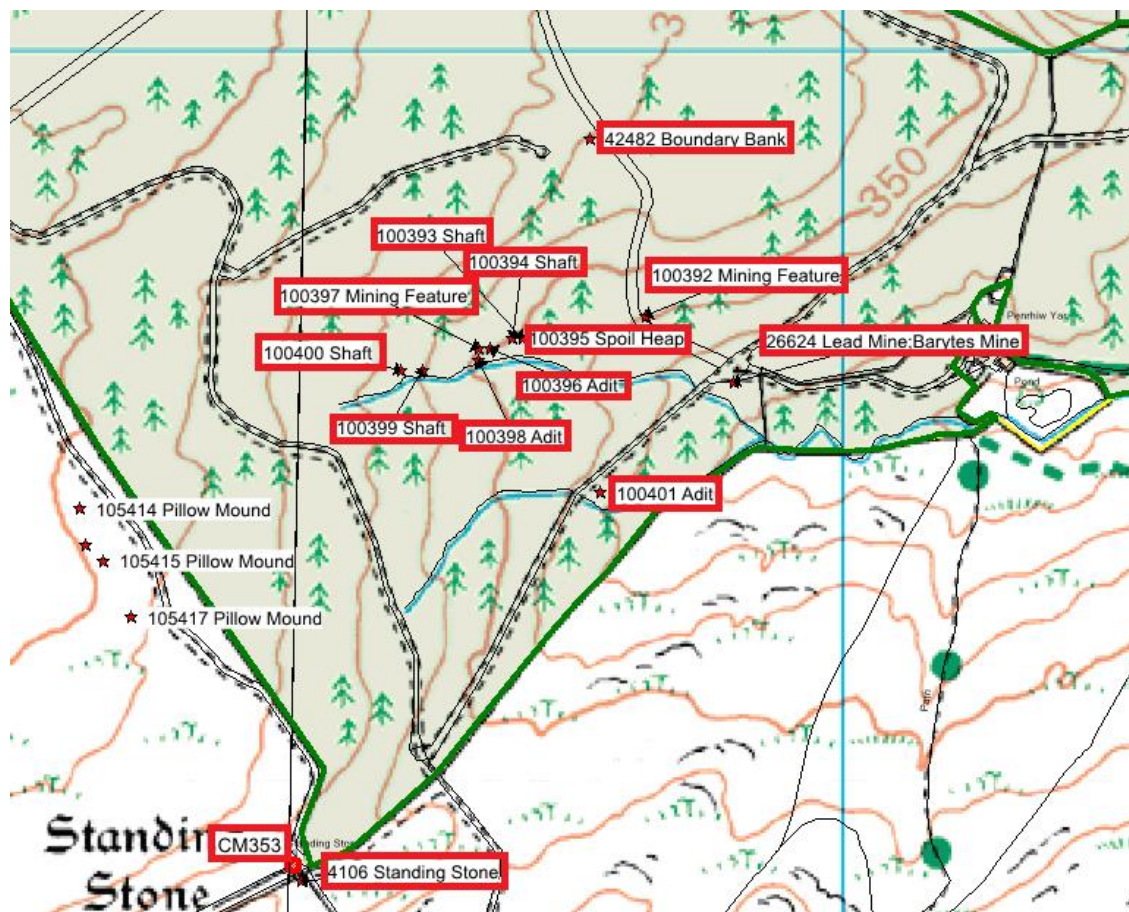

The current condition of some of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. In order to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance, DAT advise that these historic environment features (shown in green on the attached map) must be protected from damage during felling operations and that no restocking should take place within these defined areas. In addition, any ancillary operations tracks, stacking and loading areas etc must not intrude into these areas.

Although slightly outside the consultation area, it is advised that Cadw is consulted due to the proximity of PRN 4106 (Scheduled Monument CM353) to the consultation area.
