Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following features (See attached map).

PRN 54683 POST MEDIEVAL Quarry SM9696333812 A small quarry marked on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map of 1889. The feature is still visible on the 2nd edition map of 1907 but it is no longer labelled as a quarry.

PRN 54862 STONE SM9691833698
A stone marked on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map of 1889, provenance unknown.

PRN 54861 STONE SM9706433750 A stone marked on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map of 1889, provenance unknown.

PRN 54686 POST MEDIEVAL QUARRY SM9681233973 A small stone quarry to the south of Pant-y-wrack farmstead (PRN 54687) marked on the 1st edition Ordnance Survey map of 1889. RHEOLI TREFTADAETH
