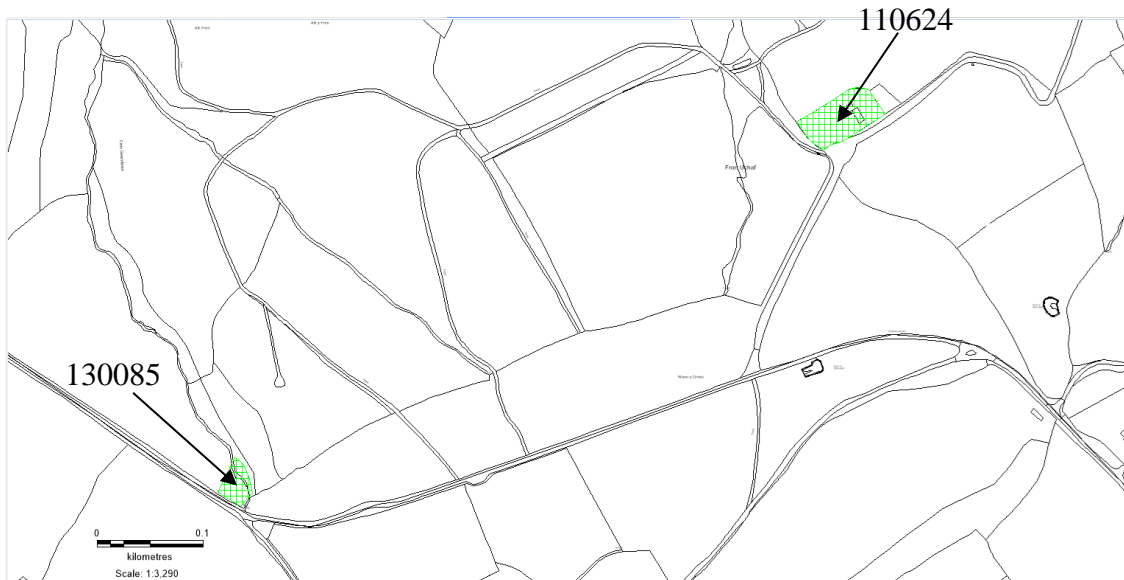

Thank you for your felling licence consultation. I have reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources and note the following feature:

Farmstead - 2 ranges at right angles (no hist. OS coverage at 1:2500 in this area). Marked and named on OS 1891 & 1906, similar form but in outline on current OS mapping. Site lies in area of forestry plantation. JS from H. Whitear 2016-17.

The application lies within the Historic Landscape Area of Allt y Ferdre. The historic maps record this area with predominantly deciduous woodland, so restocking with native broadleaf species would be more appropriate.

The current condition of these features is unknown; however, they may survive as ruins, earthworks or below ground archaeology. We advise that this historic environment features (labelled on the map above and marked with green polygons) are protected from damage during forest operations, to comply with UKFS Forests and the historic environment guidance.

There is always the possibility for previously unknown remains to survive within this area of which we have no knowledge. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified it is important that Dyfed Archaeological Trust Heritage Management is informed and further information and advice can then be provided as required.
