

Decision (If the proposal is considered to be inappropriate at this location please provide an explanation)	There are two Historic Environment Features (PRNs 19968, 121940) within the consultation area, both are historic farmsteads. Modern aerial photographs indicate these are still upstanding and may be in use still. Green polygons have been drawn around the core of the historic farmsteads, within which no planting should take place. In addition, historic field banks extend out from these two farmsteads, these must be protected from damage. A bronze age burnt mound (PRN 8526) is recorded in close proximity to the Nant yr Hafdre, but we have no up to date information on its precise location. These features are recognised as a kidney shaped mounds made up of burnt stones. We recommend that open space be incorporated into this area to avoid causing damage to this or any associated features.
