Moorewoods Consultation – Land near Llandysul

Dear Alison,

Thank you for your consultation. As per your request, I have assessed the two areas in question and reviewed the map boundaries against the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and other sources.

For the lower area, the only possible constraint I found relates to a cottage recorded on historic maps (PRN 100001). The current condition of this site is unknown, and it appears to be located just outside the proposed planting scheme. However, it is possible that some remains may extend into the area. Care should be taken to avoid causing any damage to such remains.

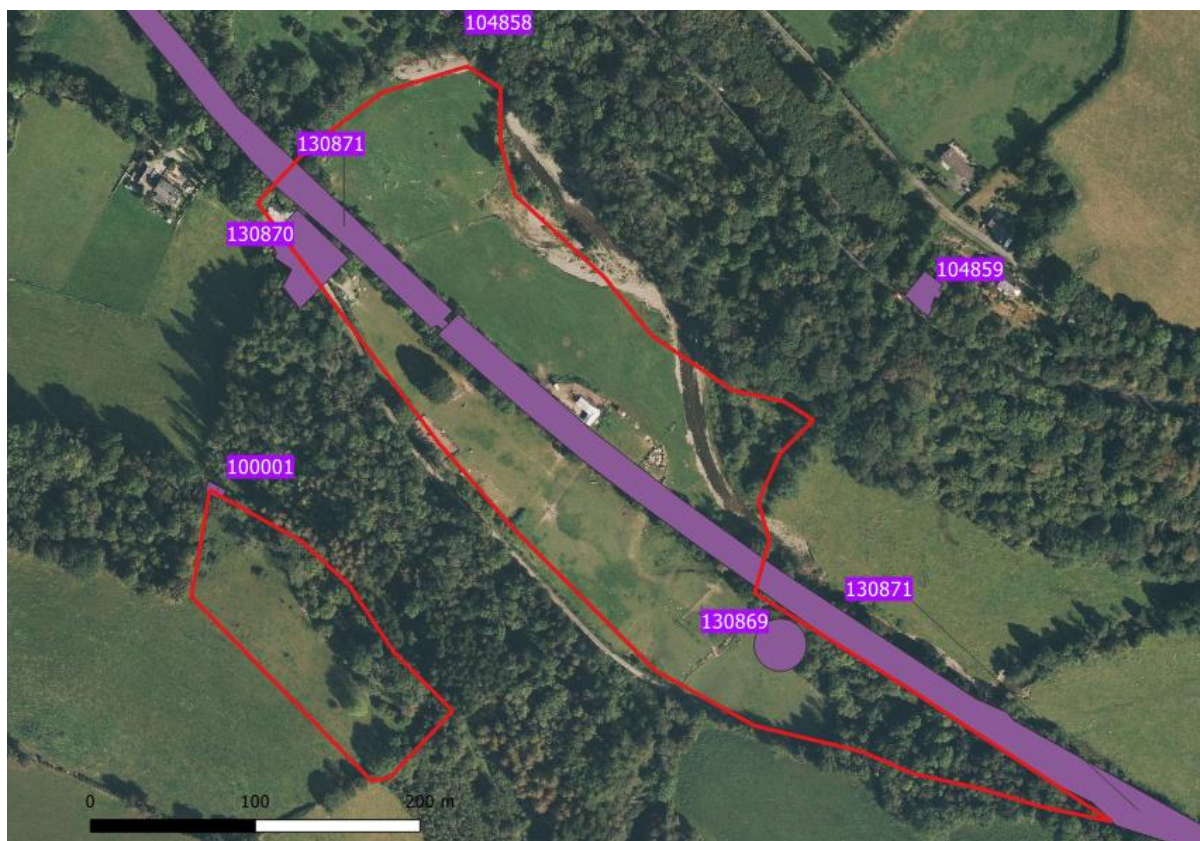
In the upper area, I noted several features likely associated with the GWR Carmarthen to Cardigan Branch. The current condition of these features is unknown, but we advise that planting should be avoided in these areas to prevent potential damage to the historic assets (these features are marked in purple on the attached map). The features may survive as ruins, earthworks, or as below-ground archaeology.

There is always the possibility that previously unknown remains could survive within this area. Should further archaeological features or finds be identified during operations, please inform Henneb – The Trust for Welsh Archaeology, Heritage Management (Dyfed region) so that we can provide further information and advice as required.
