Ar yr 2ail o Hydref 2017 cadarnhaodd Awdurdod Parc Cenedlaethol Arfordir Penfro y gorchymyn uchod.

Effaith y Gorchymyn, fel y cadarnhawyd, fydd gwyo'r rhan honno o lwybr cyhoeddus PP66/8 yng nghymuned Nanhyfer, yn rhedeg o lwybr ger Plas Lawrence, Cyfeirnod Grid OS SN 1351 4357 ac yn symud i'r de am 390 metr trwy dri chae i droi i'r dwyraint am 412 metr, gan fynd heibio i Borthdy Trefiglin ac yna'n troi i'r dde i redeg trwy gae am 188 metr at bompren wrth y ffrwd ger Castell Trefiglin, Cyfeirnod Grid OS SN 1407 4313 (cyfanswm yr hyd 990 metr) a chreu llwybr troed amgen i'w ddefnyddio yn lle llinell sy'n rhedeg o lwybr i'r de orllewin o Gwar Trefiglin, Cyfeirnod Grid OS SN 1345 4301 ac yn symud yn gyffredinol i'r dwyraint ac yna i gyfeiriad y gogledd trwy gaeau, ar hyd ymwl coedwig am 763 metr at bompren, Cyfeirnod Grid OS SN 1389 4316, yna'n troi i gyfeiriad y dwyraint am 187 metr at bompren wrth y ffrwd ger Castell Trefiglin, Cyfeirnod Grid OS SN 1407 4313 (cyfanswm yr hyd 950 metr) fel y'i dangosir ar y map gorchymyn.

Gellir cael golwg yn ddi-dâl ar gopi o'r Gorchymyn a map y Gorchymyn yn swyddfa Awdurdod Parc Cenedlaethol Arfordir Penfro, Parc Llanion, Doc Penfro, Sir Benfro, rhwng 9.00 a.m. a 4.00 p.m. ar unrhyw ddiwrnod gwaith. Gellir prynu copiâu o'r Gorchymyn a'r map yno am £2.

Daw'r gorchymyn hwn i rym ar y dyddiad y mae Awdurdod Parc Cenedlaethol Arfordir Penfro yn tystio fod y telerau o erthygl 2 o'r gorchymyn wedi eu cydymffurfio gyda, ond os yw unrhyw berson sy'n teimlo bod y Gorchymyn hwn yn eu tramgwyddo am gwestiynu ei ddilysrwydd neu ddilysrwydd unrhyw ddarpariaeth a geir ynddo, ar y sail nad ydyw o fewn pwerau'r Ddeddf uchod, neu ar y sail na chydymffurfifiyd ag unrhyw ofyniad yn y Ddeddf, neu unrhyw reoliad a wnaed o dan y Ddeddf, mewn perthynas â chadarnhau'r Gorchymyn, fe all gyflwyno cais gerbron yr Uchel Lys at unrhyw rai o'r dibenion hyn, o dan adrann 287 Deddf Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1990, o fewn chwe wythnos i'r dyddiad y cyhoeddir yr hysbysiad hwn am y tro cyntaf, fel sy'n ofynnol yn ôl paragraff 7 Atodlen 14 o'r Ddeddf honno.

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH
DIVERSION ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990,

PUBLIC FOOTPATH PP66/8 IN THE COMMUNITY
OF NEVERN, PEMBROKESHIRE
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016**

On the 2nd of October 2017 the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order, as confirmed, is to divert that part of public footpath PP66/8 in the Community of Nevern, running from a track near Plas Lawrence, OS Grid Reference SN 1351 4357 and proceeding south for 390 metres through three fields to turn east to run for 412 metres, passing Trefiglin Lodge and then turns south to run through a field for 188 metres to a footbridge at the stream near Castell Trefiglin, OS Grid Reference SN 1407 4313 (total length 990 metres) and create an alternative footpath for use as a replacement to a line running from a track south west of Trefiglin Quarry, OS Grid Reference SN 1345 4301 and proceeding in a generally easterly and then northerly direction through fields, along woodland edge for 763 metres to footbridge, OS Grid Reference SN 1389 4316, then turning to run east for 187 metres to a footbridge at the stream near Castell Trefiglin, OS Grid Reference SN 1407 4313 (total length 950 metres), as shown on the order map.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen free of charge at Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority, Llanion Park, Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire, from 9.00am to 4.00pm on any weekday. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at a price of £2.

This order comes into force on the date on which the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
