Any comments already made following the original application for planning permission (unless they are expressly confidential) will be forwarded to the Inspectorate and copied to the appellant and will be taken into account by the Inspector in deciding the appeal.

Parking is available within the site. There is access to the building for the disabled and there are disabled toilets available. If you require any special facilities, please contact us prior to the Inquiry so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
