Yn 2025, comisiynwyd Gwasanaethau Maes Heneb gan Mr Rhodri Roberts i ymgymryd â lliniaru archeolegol ar ffurf Arolwg Ffotograffig cyn gwaith datblygu ar Fferm Glanrafon, Llaneilian, Amlwch, Ynys Môn. Roedd yr arolwg ffotograffig yn cynnwys 65 o ddelweddau a oedd yn cynnwys golygfeydd allanol a mewnol o'r holl ddrychiadau ac ystafelloedd hygyrch.

NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY

In 2025, Heneb Field Services was commissioned by Mr Rhodri Roberts to undertake archaeological mitigation in the form of a Photographic Survey prior to development work at Glanrafon Farm, Llaneilian, Amlwch, Ynys Môn. The photographic survey comprised 65 images which included exterior and internal views of all elevations and accessible rooms.

1 INTRODUCTION

Heneb Field Services was commissioned by *Mr Rhodri Roberts* to undertake archaeological mitigation in the form of a Photographic Survey prior to development work at Glanrafon Farm, Llaneilian, Amlwch, Ynys Môn LL68 9NA (NGR SH46649153; cf. Figure 01).

The development will be undertaken in accordance with the granted planning consent ref. **FPL/2025/140**, with the archaeological condition set as:

• A Photographic Survey of the building prior to development.

The Photographic Survey was undertaken on the 2nd October 2025, in accordance with Requirements for General Photographic Surveys of Buildings (Heneb 2024) and commensurate to a Photographic Survey as defined in *Understanding Historic Buildings: A guide to good recording practice* (Historic England, 2016) as a very full visual record, but without a written or drawn survey at a comparable level of detail.

The photographic survey was monitored by Heneb Planning in accordance with an approved written scheme of investigation. In line with the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) requirements, the HER was contacted at the onset of the project to ensure that any data arising was formatted in a manner suitable for accession; the HER Event Primary Reference Number for this project is **49630**.

All work was planned, managed and undertaken by Heneb Field Services in accordance with the following standards and guidance:

- Guidance for the Submission of Data to the Welsh Historic Environment Records (HERs) Version 4.1 (The Welsh Archaeological Trusts, 2024);
- Guidelines for digital archives (Royal Commission on Ancient and Historic Monuments of Wales, 2015).
- Requirements for General Photographic Surveys of Buildings (Heneb 2025);
- Management of Archaeological Projects (MAP 2) (English Heritage, 1991);
- Management of Research Projects in the Historic Environment: The MoRPHE Project Managers' Guide (Historic England, 2015);
- Standard and Guidance for the Archaeological Investigation and Recording of Standing Buildings or Structures (Chartered Institute for Archaeologists, 2020a); and
- Understanding Historic Buildings: A Guide to Good Recording Practice (Historic England, 2016).

Heneb: the Trust for Welsh Archaeology is a Registered Organisation with the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists (ClfA).

2 METHOD STATEMENT

2.1 Introduction

The Photographic Survey was undertaken on the 2nd October 2025, in accordance with Requirements for General Photographic Surveys of Buildings (Heneb 2024) and commensurate to a Photographic Survey as defined in *Understanding Historic Buildings: A guide to good recording practice* (Historic England, 2016) as a very full visual record, but without a written or drawn survey at a comparable level of detail.

2.2 Photographic Record

The Photographic Record included the following:

- A general view of the building in its wider setting.
- The building's external appearance, which comprised a series of oblique views of the accessible external elevations to provide an overall impression of size, shape and immediate setting.
- The overall appearance of the principal rooms and circulation areas.
- Images of relevant external and internal structural/decorative detail that were relevant to the building's design, development and use (with scale where appropriate).
- A photographic register detailing the photo number, the location and direction of each view (<u>Appendix I</u>).
- Photograph locations and directions of view marked on plans, based on WM Design and Architecture Drawing Nos. 2088 A.01.01 to 2088 A.01.03 (Figure 02).
- Photographs using an archive quality digital SLR set to maximum resolution.
- Photographs, where appropriate, using a clearly visible, graduated metric scale.

Photographic images were taken using a digital SLR (Canon EOS R7) camera set to maximum resolution (6960×4640; 32 effective megapixels) in CR3 (RAW) format. A photographic record was maintained on site using Heneb Field Services pro-formas and digitised in Microsoft Excel as part of the fieldwork archive and dissemination process; a total of 65 images were taken (archive ref.: E49630_1 to E49630_65). The photographic images were converted to TIFF for final archiving using proprietary software.

2.3 Written Record

The Written Record comprised:

- The precise location of the building as an address and in the form of a National Grid reference.
- A note of any statutory designation (that is, listing, scheduling, Register of Historic Parks and Gardens, conservation area), where applicable.
- The date when the record was made, the name(s) of the recorder(s) and the location of the archive material.
- A summary statement describing the building's type and purpose, historically and at present, materials and any dating, so far as was apparent from a superficial inspection.

A basic written record was completed using Heneb Field Services pro-formas.

2.4 Drawn Record

The Drawn Record comprised:

 A plan showing the location and direction of view of each photograph. In this instance, the scaled plans detailed in WM Design and Architecture Drawing Nos. 2088 A.01.01 to 2088 A.01.03 (Figure 02) was used for reference and as a base plan.

2.5 Dissemination & Archiving

The physical archive is stored in a designated project folder and the location confirmed in the Data Management Plan; the digital dataset is stored on a dedicated Trust server, with the location confirmed in the Data Management Plan via a specific hyperlink. The working project archive in this instance comprises digital data including photographic data, documentation and written data, as well as paper records, including project pro-formas. The Data Management Plan is stored on a project specific form in the Heneb Field Services project database (format: *Microsoft* Access) and a Selection Strategy has been completed and appended (cf. <u>Appendix II</u>). The following dissemination and archiving of the report and digital dataset were applied:

- A digital report has been provided to Rhodri Roberts and Heneb Planning (draft report then final report);
- A digital report has been provided to the regional Historic Environment Record; this
 was submitted within six months of project completion, along with a digital dataset
 comprising an Event PRN summary. The report and dataset was submitted in
 accordance with the required standards set out in *Guidance for the Submission of Data*to the Welsh Historic Environment Records (HERs) (Version 4.1); and
- A digital report and digital archive dataset has been provided to the Royal Commission on Ancient and Historical Monuments, Wales (final report only), in accordance with the RCAHMW Guidelines for Digital Archives Version 1. The dataset was prepared in the format required by RCAHMW and included:
 - Photographic metadata (Microsoft Access);
 - Photographic archive (TIFF format);
 - Project Information form (Excel);
 - File Information form (Excel) Microsoft Word report text final;
 - File Information form (Excel) Photographic metadata (general);
 - File Information form (Excel) Adobe PDF report final; and
 - o File Information form (Excel) Photographic metadata (detail).

3 RESULTS

3.1 Introduction

Glanrafon farmhouse is located in Llaneilian, Amlwch, Ynys Môn, LL68 9NA, and appears to be built in the early 20th century and first appears on the 1926 Anglesey County Series OS 6-inch to 1 mile map sheet III, the exterior of the farmhouse is pebble dashed. There are two storeys, with all the northeast facing elevation including two PVC windows one on the ground floor and one on the first floor and a PVC door that leads into the kitchen. The east-southeast facing includes a wooden door in a later extension that was added to the east-southeast elevation this doorway leads into a toilet area. The southwest elevation includes three PVC windows on the ground floor and one window on the first floor that is missing its frame. The west-northwest elevation includes two PVC windows set either side of a central wooden doorway and three PVC windows on the first floor.

The building comprised the following:

- a ground floor, including kitchen, utility room, living room, pantry, dining room and toilet. The internal walls between the pantry and living room and the dining room and staircase had been removed. All the interior walls have been stripped of any plaster and revealed a random mix of field stones and bricks which had been bonded by mortar. Some original features survive such as the range and cupboard in the kitchen, the red and black tiled guarry stone floor in the kitchen and utility room
- a first floor, including three bedrooms, a bathroom, and a landing area. All the interior
 walls have been stripped of any plaster and revealed a random mix of field stones
 bonded by mortar, with modern brick infill present. Floors were timber sitting on timber
 joists. Visible roofing comprised wooden purlins and joists that appeared to be modern
 replacement and/or repair.

4 CONCLUSION

Heneb Field Services was commissioned by Rhodri Roberts to undertake archaeological mitigation, consisting of a photographic survey, prior to development works at Llaneilian, Amlwch, Ynys Môn. The photographic survey comprised 65 images which included exterior and internal views of all elevations and accessible rooms

The building appears to have been built in the early 20th century and first appears on the 1926 Anglesey County Series OS 6-inch to 1 mile map sheet III and comprises two storeys. The exterior was clad in pebbledash render whilst the interior had been stripped of, plaster fixtures and fittings prior to the survey, exposing stone and brick; some internal partitions had ben removed and the ground floor joists exposed. Modern PVC window fittings had replaced the originals, and the roof joists and purlins also appeared to have been replaced with modern timber. A later extension had been added to the east-southeast ground floor elevation leading into a toilet area.






