II* c1750 with some minor 19C modifications. Addition on west and south. Unique example of brick Georgian mansion of English type in Anglesey, with wealth of interior detail. Built by William Jones. Red brick, 3 storeys and cellar, 7 windows including 3 window centre slightly advanced with pediment above. Hipped slate roof. Dash windows with glazing bars.
