II Said to be 16C., reconstructed in the early 19C by Hampton Lewis and with later minor alterations. 2 storeyed and attic. 6 window entrance front with 4 window wip at right angles forming an L on plan. Roof of thin slates. Recessed wash windows with glazyp bars. Small gabled dormers to attic. Wip has gabled projection near centre, with stepped gable, and a dummy window at ground floor, probably in lieu of former entrance, with tablet above inscribed 00 J 1529. Date of main construction is probably c1820, and the date tablet, 1848, referring to later minor alterations. Interior: doors with 6 sunk panels,

marble mantels including some of early 19c. Ancient masonry foundations in basement, said to be of Roman centurion's residence. Ref in RCAM p.145.
