II* 1679 by Owen Williams, with reconstruction in early 18C and early 19C. 2 storeys and attic. Long rectangular main block with central projection at rear including stair - South-east front, grey gnt rendered 8 windows with 2 windows to west. Roof with fairly old slates, and tall stone chimneys with capping. Dash windows with exposed frames, thick bars and small panes. Added porch, and altered entrance door. Interior: door with obelisk moulded architrave, door with two fielded panels, plastered beams. Panelled reveals to windows, stair with thick turned balusters, pulvinate frieze, square newels with ball finials, moulded rail, and panelled respond.

Stone mantel with fluted Tonic pilasters and curved pediment. Mantel with arched beams of crossed axes and 3 ravens and chevron.
c 1830 marble mantels. Attic has original roof trusses, heavy planks, in-and-out partition and oak boarding. Old dairy wing has pigeon holes in gable. RCAM ref p.139
