II\* Earliest part 1686, 2 storeys and attic and cellar, 4 windows, south-east and 2 narrow windows in gabled end of wing projecting at right angles. Further 1 wing added extension north-east. Originally built as ferry house. Mortared rubble masonry, part with rough-cast, lime-washed. Roof of old small slates, that of front wing with repairs. Somewhat recessed sash windows with glazing bars. Entrance door has rectangular fan with glazing bars. Original stone tall square chimneys at west and south, other chimneys with brick stacks. Interior: heavy beams, room with raised, fielded, bisection moulded panelling, thick walls with window

seats. Original heavy roof trusses with curved collars and delicate
