- II c. 1848. Formerly the residence of the Government engineer in charge of the new harbour construction. An interesting example of early Victorian castellated architecture in the idiom of Oxford Castle. Stucco, 2 storeys. 6 barred windows in square hood-moulds. 2 embattled porches. The whole embattled and crenellated, with numerous turrets and bartizans. An elaborate stone curtain wall with numerous towers encloses the estate on the north-east.
