- I Late 3rd or early 4th C. The enceinte of a Roman fort, the original walls survive and enclosing the parish church. Constructed rubble faced with dressed stones. The north and south walls are almost intact, with remains of circular towers in the angles. The south wall has a gateway of two arches (rebuilt). On the west the wall is partly obscured by modern houses.
