A Earlier medieval south aisle, to north aisle and arcade and possibly the porch added in late 15C. Church on site since A.D. 615. Double aisled. West portion has roof with oak braced trusses and renewed purlins and rafters. Central arcade has 6 bays of 14th century arches, four being exposed as ruin. 14C south doorway. Oldest register 1666. Used as parish church until 1839. Ref in R.C.A.M. p.99
