- III Mainly 19C, incorporating very early 17C doorway, as entrance, with stopped moulded jambs and arched head. 1 storey, 2 windows with wip to rear. Coursed rough hewn masonry. Slate roof with 3 small blank gables to front. Windows have flat heads of voussoirs and hood band. Unoccupied. Windows boarded up. Reference in PLANS p. 102. 18C square stone gatepiers with oval finials, and low walls, with restored railings above in iron.
