- A Possibly the west wall and greater part of north and south walls are 12C. Rubble masonry. Roof with modern slates. 12C window remains in south wall and fragments of chevron etc. have been reset above modernised south doorway. Restored in modern times, 14C monument to St. Pabo. Roof of chancel and nave, with medieval oak-braced trusses, modern rafters and purlins.
