- I Incorporating doorway probably late medieval. House rebuilt on the site in 1470. Extensive alterations in 1783-5, by John Cooper of Classical character as well as battlemented parapet. 1795 reconstruction in gothic style by James Wyatt including chapel wing and probably the stables. Interior: late Georgian stair appears to be by Wyatt. 3 storeys and basement. Limestone ashlar masonry. South front, to Merai Strait 5 window centre including 3-window bay, with 1 window like to 3-window splayed pavilion. Each bay has 'gothic' window at ground floor. Moulded cornice below plain parapet. Recessed rear windows, with gable bay, and with moulded chaco bands. 9-window later extension, east with

plain band at 1st floor cill and below parapet. *Delate* varis.
