II* late C16 or early C17, altered in late C17. (when extended at S. end) and again in modern times. 2 storeys. Originally rectangular in plan, with projecting chimney-stack and overhanging upper storey, but lower walls removed in modern times and projection underbuilt. Pebble-dash to walls of stone + some brick + timber framing. Slate roof. 6 unevenly-spaced sash windows (with grating bars on lower storey) including one of 3-light on the right. 5-panel door in recessed frame with small wooden pediment removed since last survey. Vault entry + rail-shrouded passage door. Projecting stone chimney at N. end similar one internally at S. end. There is considerable original timber framing + panelling (mainly lapped vert boarding) including some step-chamfered beams and re-used ~~even~~ C17 panelling.
