- II C1830, perhaps a remodelling of older fabric. There was a house on the site back to the Elizabethan period, 2 storeys. Tregulus plan. Pebble-dashed. Hipped roof of small do slates. Main E. front: 3 unevenly spaced small windows with glazing bars, the lower side ones being 3-window bays. Central double doors of 6 panels (bottom 2 fielded, rest glazed), under elliptical head. Fan with glazing bars. Wide, gabled, glazed porch on gestic-panelled posts. Barge-boards with railway-type fret. Moulded finial. Porch door glazed over 2 fielded panels. Framed by semi-colonettes and small straight hood. 2-storey 3-window bay added on left in C20 (with overthrown to adjacent bay). Rear has round-headed small windows, with gestic glazing bars, + 2-storey wing
