II* like C18 but incorporating earlier work and with early C19 alterations and additions. 3 storeys and attic. Rendered rubble. Date ref.
Symmetrical. 3-bay window at either end and 3 windows between. Sashes, those on first floor with graying bars. 3 hipped dormers with sliding sashes and graying bars. Central door of 6 panels (top 4 grayed). Finely moulded doorcase, with architrave, fluted pilasters and pediment (removed in period of 2nd World War but now restored). There is a curved void between capitals and pediment in place of entablature. Interior has main stair a quarter spiral with Victorian scroll on reveal, 2 fluted pilasters and dentilled cornice in upper first room, 6-panel doors,

shouldered architrave or landing, paneling etc. Upper flights of each stair
have slender turned balusters of early C18 type
