Dressed local stone coping and chamber. Upper gate replaced by stop planks. Single lower gate timber with gate paddle gearing.

Bottom quadrant abuts road bridge with no towpath. The lock has been fenced with galvanised railings and footbridge at top of the lock.

Despite the modern fencing this is one of the best preserved locks on the canal. The Swansea Canal was built in 1873-4.
