Footbridge over Swansea Canal. Rebuilt 1887. Coursed rubble-stone abutments with some later brick dressings and stone capstones. Riveted metal plate girder utilising pairs of broad gauge rail as parapet rail/tie band. Date stone "1887" built into southern abutment. The bridge is marked on the GWR-Swansea Canal Map of 1874 and was therefore rebuilt in 1887. Although the abutments have been substantially rebuilt, the bridge itself is very well preserved and an interesting example of the ownership of the canal.
