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F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Public road bridge, skew to the canal. Built 1932. Re-enforced concrete, dressed with coursed rustic stone. Re-enforced concrete road deck. Parallel parapet and continuous wingwalls along road level, terminating in square piers with pyramidal capstones.

The canal leaves the Brecon Beacons National Park to the south of this bridge, and is classified as a Remainder Waterway from this point.
