Description:

Public road bridge. 1994. Re-enforced concrete abutments and road deck. Sloping wingwalls parallel to canal, dressed with uncoursed rustic stone and having concrete copings. Steel handrails to parapet, painted green. Parapet has plate reading " Rebuilt 1994 Crown Bridge Bridge No 48" to both elevations. No towpath beneath the bridge, and access to the opposite side via road.
