Accommodation bridge. c1812 with later rebuilding. William Crossley engineer. Coursed dressed rubble sandstone. Elliptical arch with protruding keystones. Flat stone copings. Terminating piers show signs of rebuilding; southern towside parapet has been rebuilt to slope down to remodelled pier.
