F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Public road bridge. c1812 with C19 and C20 renewal. William Crossley engineer. Coursed rubble sandstone, heavily jointed with mortar. Elliptical arch with dressed stone voussoirs and prominent keystones. Hump-backed parapet with flat stone copings, replaced in places with concrete and engineering brick. Slightly protruding terminating piers. Wooden steps up to road level.
