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F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Public road bridge. c1812 with C19 and C20 renewal. William Crossley engineer. Coursed rubble sandstone. Segmental arch has been rebuilt with engineering brick voussoirs and soffit, and reconstituted stone beneath springing line. Slightly hump-backed parapet with engineering brick copings. Plastic pipe carried on MC20 rubble stone abutments just south of the bridge.
