F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Accommodation bridge. c1812 with C20 rebuilding. William Crossley engineer. Coursed rubble sandstone, renewed to the parapet of both elevations. Elliptical arch with dressed stone voussoirs, patched in places and prominent keystones. Hump-backed parapet with flat copings. Slightly protruding terminating piers, with red brick rebuilding.
