




Monument Name:	Aqueduct 16 – over three tunnels

Description:	

Aqueduct over three tunnels each, on the face, under a semicircular relieving arch spanning between raking buttresses. The tunnels might be more accurately called "tubes"; the outer ones are circular but the central tube is elliptical.

Their purpose is not known. It is suggested that the elliptical tunnel is for horses; and the 1st OS (below) shows a well define track passing through. The outer tubes are likely to have been for flood relief, the earth bank otherwise acting as a dam to the flood waters of the nearby river (see MB206).
